When you are planning a trip abroad, you should contact us at least eight weeks (*ideally*) before you go. This will give you adequate time to discuss any vaccinations that you might need.

The vaccinations you need will depend on:

- where you are travelling to,
- any existing medical conditions that you have
- any medication that you are already taking.

As well as having vaccinations for common diseases in the country that you are travelling to, you should make sure that you are up-to-date with your booster jabs, such as tetanus.

We can provide some travel vaccinations for free (but *only to our own patients*). These **usually** include:

Typhoid Hepatitis A Meningitis C
and Tetanus/Diphtheria/Polio (*combined in one vaccine*)

You will need to pay for most other travel vaccinations:

- Yellow Fever,
- Meningococcal Meningitis,
- Japanese and Tick-Borne Encephalitis,
- Hepatitis B
- Rabies

Always follow the instructions which come with your medication.

Travel Vaccinations now lie outside of the NHS and are NOT ALL FREE. We have teamed up with MASTA TRAVEL HEALTH so that we can offer you a high quality travel health service.

Our Masta Travel Health Clinic can provide comprehensive travel health advice, vaccinations and anti-malarials for our own patients and for the general public travelling abroad.

Although you may have to pay for some of your travel vaccinations, it is very important that you have them. Some of the health conditions listed in this leaflet can be fatal, so it is important that you and your family are adequately protected against them.

Anti-malaria medication is **not free**. You will usually need to start taking this type of medicine about three weeks before you travel, and continue taking it while you are away.
